

Heart Coasters



Hoop: 100mm x 100mm
Stitches From: 4,945 to 6578
Colors: 7
Width: 99.8mm
Length: 95.7mm

Items needed:

Quilt Batting: 4 x 4 inches

Fabric:

2 Pieces 4½ x 4½ inches, Top and Bottom. (Same or Different Colors)

Embroidery Thread:

Wind a bobbin the same color as the thread used for the Satin Border.

Stabilizer: "Wash-Away"


1 piece large enough to hoop in the 100mm x 100mm hoop.

Embroidery Hoop: 100mm x 100mm or Larger (4 x 4 inches)

Scotch Tape

Appliqué Scissors or Sharp Curved Scissors

You don't have to change the thread 7 times. Thread colors are used to prompt your embroidery machine to stop after each step. Start with a thread color that matches your fabric. **Hoop the Stabilizer.**



1  Sew the placement stitch for the Quilt Batting. Lay the Batting over the outline. Make sure the entire outline is covered.

Sew the Batting in place.





Remove the hoop and trim close to the stitches. Replace the Hoop.



Lay the **Top 4½ x 4½ inch** piece of fabric on top of the Batting.



Sew the fabric in place. **Do Not**

Trim.




Sew the Saying.



Remove the hoop. Lay the **Bottom** fabric, (4½ x 4½ inch), face up. Make sure the Stitches are covered. Tape the corners to secure in place. Replace the Hoop.



Sew the bottom in Place. Remove the Hoop.




Trim the Front and Back close to the edges. Replace the Hoop. Change the **top** and **bottom** thread to matching colors for the next step.



Sew the Satin stitch.

Change the top thread to the accent color for the Decorative stitch.



Sew the Decorative stitch.

Remove the hoop. Cut around the Coaster to remove it from the Hoop. Trim as close as possible to the stitches. Remove the excess Stabilizer by wetting your finger and rubbing along the edges. If you make it too wet, it will cause the fabric to pucker and wrinkle. If that happens you will have to soak the coaster to dissolve all the stabilizer inside.

Repeat this step to sew the other 3 coasters, or combined the files. Use a larger hoop to sew all 4 at one time.
